Program Overview

NorQuest College has partnered with the Community Adult Learning Program (CALP) to offer high school and college preparatory programming, as well as English language training, in communities around Alberta.

Foundations for Learning includes a range of 12-week online courses to rural learners at a reduced tuition rate. Each course is approximately 45 hours of instructor-led activities presented in an online real-time or online anytime delivery format. In addition, 30 hours of in-person tutorial support are available to you for free in your community at the local CALP provider.

Admission Requirements

- it is recommended that applicants take a [NorQuest College placement assessment](#) to determine the appropriate levels of study

ELP Requirements

If English is your second language, you must provide proof of English language proficiency (ELP) prior to admission. ELP test results must have been obtained within two years of the start date of your program.

Acceptable evidence of ELP may be one of the following test scores:

- CLBA: no section score below 5
- IELTS Academic: 5
- TOEFL iBT: 40
- CELPIP General: 5
- minimum of 80% in [ESLS 5000](#) or [ESLS 5100](#), and 80% in [ESLW 5000](#) or [ESLW 5100](#)
